Dedication of the 10th International Senefelder Award

The award – in memory of Alois Senefelder, the founder of the lithography technique – will be dedicated by the International Senefelder Foundation for the 10th time in order to honor extraordinary performances in the field of artistic lithography and its further development into flat-bed printing. The award is scheduled to distribute a total of Euro 15,000 in prize money (1st prize Euro 7,500, 2nd prize Euro 5,000, 3rd prize Euro 2,500).
