International Senefelder Foundation to hold an exhibition in Hamburg.

In the Museum of Work (Museum der Arbeit) in Hamburg, the Foundation is to exhibit a retrospection of three decades of lithographic works produced by its award winners.

On the occasion of the 6th North German Hand Press Exhibition, the International Senefelder Foundation is to make a special presentation of around 40 works produced by its award winners including lithographs by Stefan Szczesny, Barbara Beisinghoff, Koichi Bugihara, Bard Varbaenen, Bruno Bruni, and Jim Dine. Also on display will be the work of Ms. Kuniko Tadokoro, the winner of the tenth Senefelder Award. The calligraphically valuable artbook produced by the Japanese artist and lithographer was awarded a prize of 7500 euros in November 2008.

The 6th North German Hand Press Exhibition will be held in Hamburg's Museum of Work from 16 to 18. January 2009. 50 book artists from Germany and abroad are to show their treasures, accompanied by interesting fringe events focusing on lithography and contemporary Turkish book art from the Guest of Honour of the 2008 Frankfurt Book Fair.

Sarah Bodman from the University of the West of England in Bristol will talk about "Digital Printing and Traditional Printing Technology". The International Senefelder Foundation will be represented by its executive board member Karl-Heinz Döbert. Numerous presentations will show Ebru marbling technique, book printing, type casting, lithography, papermaking and much more.

All activities are to be managed by BuchDruckKunst e.V. Hamburg with whom the International Senefelder Foundation has cooperated closely for years.
